

PUNEBAL OF MICHAEL O'CONNOB.

At ten o'clock this morning the remains of Michael O'Connor, the gentleman who was run over and killed by a Southern Railroad train on Tuesday evening, were conveyed from his late residence at Richmond Hill to St. Monios's Roman Catholic Church at Jamaica, where was offered up for the repose of his soul a grand high mass. The funeral cortege was a large one, comprising many coaches from Brooklyn. Nearly the entire population of Jamaica were in the body of the church, including all the representative men of Catholic and Protestant faith. The remains reposed in a beautiful rosewood casket, silver mounted, and the foral tributes were numerous and beautiful. Mr. O'Connor was highly respected by his Protestant friends for his gentlemanly bearing and uprightness of character, and was beloved by his Catholic friends for his liberal support of the church. The congregation being composed of men of moderate means, his liberality lightened their burden very materially. Father Farley, pastor of the church, preached an eloquent sermon, and paid a high tribute to the character of the deceased. The remains were interred in Calvary Comctery.
